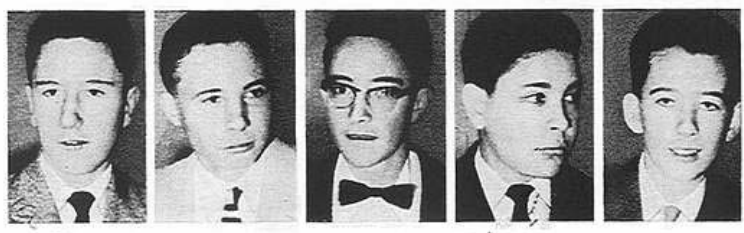

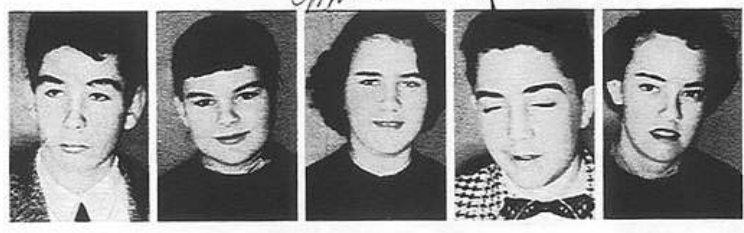

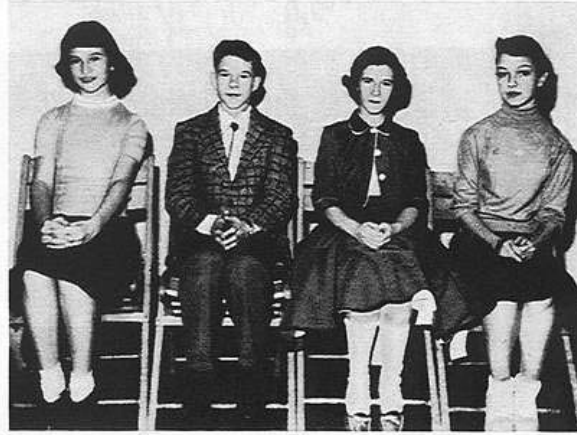

Many of our members will be with us again next year when we hope to see as much enthusiasm as we boasted this year.

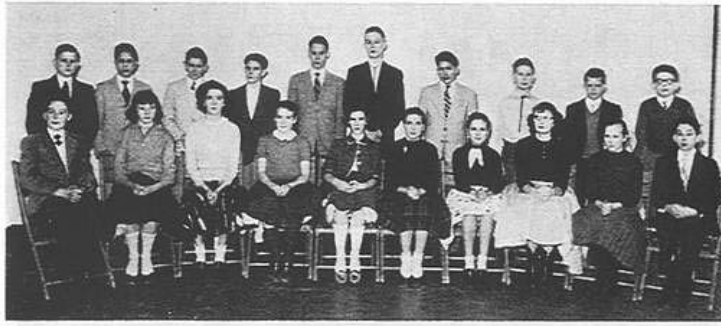
